NOTIFICATION

The 23rd July, 2010

No. FSA.103/2002/272 :- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 30 of the Consumer Protection Act, 1986 (68 of 1986), the Governor of Assam is hereby pleased to make the following rules to amend the Assam State Consumer Protection Rules, 1989, hereinafter referred to as the principal Rules, namely :-

Short Title and
Commencement

1. (1) These rules may be called the *Assam State Consumer Protection (Amendment) Rules, 2010*.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.

Amendment of
Rule-3.

2. In the principal Rules, in Rule-3, for sub-rule (1), the following shall be substituted, namely :-

"(1) The President of District Forum shall receive the salary of the Judge of District Court plus 60 Ltr. of POL per month if appointed on whole time basis or a consolidated honorarium of Rs. 1000/- plus Conveyance allowance of Rs. 150/- per day of sitting, if appointed on part time basis. Other Members if appointed on whole time basis shall receive consolidated honorarium of Rs. 20000/- plus 50 Ltr of POL per month and if sitting on part time basis, a consolidated honorarium of Rs. 600/- plus conveyance allowance of Rs. 150/- per day for the sitting :

Provided that the whole time President and Members of the District Consumer Forum shall not be allowed to take any other assignment in any other organisation whether Government or Non-Government and they shall also not be allowed to take any remuneration from any other sources except pension. The whole time President and Members of the District Consumer Forum shall attend office on a full time basis i.e. normal working hours and working days will be applicable to them :

Provided further that the whole time President and Members of the District Consumer Forum shall not indulge in any activity that may amount to criticism of or working against the Government. They will also not indulge in any activity that may amount to breach of moral turpitude."

Amendment of
Rule-6.

3. In the Principa; Rules, in Rule-6 :-

(i) for sub-rule (1), the following shall be substituted, namely :-

"(1) The President of State Commission shall receive the salary of the Judge of the High Court plus 75 Ltr. of POL per month if appointed on whole time basis or a consolidated honorarium of Rs. 1500/- plus conveyance allowance of Rs.200/- per day for the sitting if appointed on part time basis. Other Members if sitting on whole time basis shall receive consolidated honorarium of Rs. 20000/- plus 60 Ltr. of POL per month or in case of retired Government Servant, last pay drawn minus pensions with 60 Ltr. of POL per month and if sitting on part time basis, a consolidated honorarium of Rs. 1000/- plus conveyance allowance of Rs. 200/- per day for the sitting. :

Provided that the whole time President and Members of State Commission shall not be allowed to take any other assignment in any other organization whether Government or Non-Government and he shall not be allowed to take any remuneration from any other sources except pension. The whole time President and Members of State Commission shall attend office on a full time basis i.e. normal Government working hours and working days will be applicable to them :

Provided further that the whole time president and Members of the State Commission shall not indulge in any activity that may amount to criticism or working against the Government. They will also not indulge in any activity that may amount to breach of moral turpitude".

(ii) in sub-rule (2), for the existing provision, the following shall be substituted, namely :-

"(2) The President of the State Commission shall be eligible for Travelling Allowance and other amenities as admissible to that of the sitting High Court Judge.

The Members of the State Commission shall be eligible for Travelling Allowance and other amenities as admissible to that of a Senior Grade Officer of the State Government along with a Bunglo/Office peon."

(iii) for sub-rule (4), the following shall be substituted, namely :-

"(4) The President and Members of State Commission shall hold office for a term of 5 years or up to 67 years of age, which ever is earlier and shall be eligible for re-appointment as per provisions of the Consumer Protection Act, 1986 (Act 68 of 1986).

The President and the Members of the District Forum shall hold office for a term of 5 years or up to 65 years of age, which ever is earlier and shall be eligible for re-appointment as per provisions of the consumer Protection Act, (Act 68 of 1986)."
