No. FSA 81/2009/Pt-III/387: The Governor of Assam is pleased to notify that the Principal Secretaries of Autonomous Councils/ Deputy Commissioners and Senior Most Officers of FCS & CA Department in the District shall release the FP Shop Dealer's Margin and Transportation Cost related to lifting and distribution of foodgrains under NFSA, 2013 and PMGKAY etc. within 7 days through PFMS after release of fund from the Director, FCS&CA through PFMS.

The mapping of FP Shops licensees and transporters as Vendors in the PFMS is a pre-requisite. Therefore, all FP Shop owners' and transporters' bank accounts are to be added in the PFMS by the Districts/ Autonomous Councils.

FPS Dealers' Margin intended for the FP Shop will have to be credited to the bank accounts of the FP Shop dealers only through PFMS. Similarly, transportation cost shall be credited to the bank accounts of the transporters through PFMS only. Zero balance in the PFMS accounts shall be ensured by the District authority to ensure further clearance of funds from Govt. of India.
